- COUNCIL ON ACCESS, PREVENTION AND INTERPROFESSIONAL RELATIONS.
  - To recommend policies and formulate programs relating to community oral health. To maintain liaison with oral health agencies.
- COUNCIL ON SESSIONS AND PROGRAMS.
  - To help plan and conduct the Annual Midwinter and Annual Summer Meetings. To plan and coordinate other NDA sessions or regional meetings.
- COUNCIL ON COMMUNICATIONS.
  - To identify, review and recommend, prior to implementation, programs to educate the public about oral health. To identify public and media relations issues. To assist the dental editor and to support component dental societies with their media and community relations programs and communications with members. To review communication messages to the public and to the members concerning the public and private image of dentistry.
- COUNCIL ON DENTAL EDUCATION.
  - To monitor and disseminate information on continuing dental education and to encourage the provision of and participation in continuing dental education. To liaison with the UNLV School of Dental Medicine.
- COUNCIL ON DENTAL PRACTICE.
  - To formulate and recommend policies relating to dental practice. To study, evaluate and disseminate information concerning various forms of business organization of a dental practice.
- COUNCIL ON ETHICS, BYLAWS AND JUDICIAL AFFAIRS.
  - To consider proposals for amending ADA's Principles of Ethics and Code of Professional Conduct. To provide advisory opinions regarding the interpretation of ADA's Principles of Ethics and Code of Professional Conduct. To review the Articles of the Incorporation and Bylaws in order to keep them consistent with the NDA's program. To recommend editorial corrections in the Bylaws. To act as the Standing Committee on Constitution and Bylaws of the House of Delegates.
